

THE RIDGEWOOD HIGH SCHOOL BAND PROGRAM

The Ridgewood High School Band Program is renowned as one of New Jersey's top comprehensive music programs, and is Bergen County's largest band program with over 200 students involved each year. The impressive array of curricular and co-curricular ensembles is organized in a logical sequence of instruction, which helps each student develop his or her talent and ability while maintaining the highest standards of performance. Each of our performing ensembles and related groups has received superior ratings at festivals and competitions around the country in all areas of band performance, from concert band to jazz ensemble, and chamber music to marching band. Our reputation for quality music performances is second only to the reputation we enjoy for the outstanding quality of young adults who pass through our ensembles.

The Band Program enjoys a history nearly a century old. During the past decade, Ridgewood High School band students have performed in major venues ranging from Lincoln Center's Alice Tully Hall, one of the world's most prestigious concert halls, to the famed Jack Morton Auditorium in Washington, DC and New York City's Madison Square Garden. Our groups have appeared at colleges and universities including Harvard University, George Mason University, and the University of Southern California, and have worked with some of the music world's greatest composers, conductors, and solo performers.

The Band Program is just one facet of the award winning music department at Ridgewood High School, which has twice been named a Grammy Arts School. The Band program is also proud to have played an important role in the National Association of Music Merchants decision to name Ridgewood one of the "Best Communities for Music Education in America." Other awards have included NJAJE Finalist status for both jazz ensembles, more than a dozen appearances at the Chamber Music Society of Lincoln Center's Young Musicians Concert, and the Cadets Award for Excellence along with a third place finish for the Marching Band at this year's US Bands National Championship. Individually, members of the Ridgewood High School Bands are chosen annually to perform in honors ensembles at the county, regional, state and all-eastern levels.

FACULTY



Jeffrey G. Haas, has been Director of Bands at Ridgewood High School since 1988. He currently conducts the Wind Ensemble, and co-directs the Concert Band and Symphonic Band. He also directs the Jazz Lab Ensemble and Saxophone Ensemble, and coaches several chamber music ensembles. Between 1988 and 2001, he directed the RHS Marching Band, which won two USSBA circuit championships and two state championships under his direction. In 1997, the pit orchestra for the New Players production of "The Secret Garden" was recognized with the Paper Mill Playhouse "Rising Star" award for Outstanding Student Orchestra under his direction. He also coached the student saxophone ensembles to five consecutive appearances at the Lincoln Center Chamber Music Society's Young Musicians Concert in 2002 through 2006 and again in 2015.

During the course of his 30-year career, Mr. Haas has been recognized several times for his contributions to music education. In June of 1998, Mr. Haas received the Disney American Teacher Award for Outstanding Achievement in the Performing Arts, and he was named "North Jersey Music Educator of the Year" by William Paterson University that same year. In June of 2004, he was named as the Ridgewood High School recipient of the Ridgewood Teacher Recognition Award. In 2011, Mr. Haas was the New Jersey recipient of the "Directors Who Make a Difference" Award presented by School Band & Orchestra Magazine, and in 2013 he was a semi-finalist nominee for the first ever Grammy Music Educator Award. Most recently, Mr. Haas was the recipient of the 2014 "Jazz Education Achievement Award" presented by the New Jersey Association for Jazz Education.

Mr. Haas holds degrees in music education from Syracuse University (B.M., Cum Laude, Performance Honors) and Columbia University (M.A., Magna Cum Laude), and has done considerable graduate study in the areas of conducting and educational leadership. He has served on the executive board of the New Jersey Association for Jazz Education since 1991, as President from 1997-1999, and currently as Vice President of that organization, chairing the annual jazz educators conference at NJPAC, and the professional development committee. He is also a past executive board member for the New Jersey Music Educators Association. Mr. Haas has served as conductor of the 1990 Region I Junior Jazz Ensemble, the 1995 Rockland County (NY) All County Band, the 1996 Bergen County Band, and the 2015 Region I Senior Jazz Ensemble. He has also been a guest conductor with the Ridgewood Concert Band.

As a professional saxophonist, Mr. Haas has appeared with New York Voices, Rob McConnell, Freddie Hubbard, Bob Hope, and Vanessa Williams. He has been a featured soloist with the Ridgewood Symphony Orchestra and the Ridgewood Concert Band, and he directs his own professional big band consisting of jazz educators who share his dedication to exposing students to great classic and contemporary jazz compositions and arrangements. He has presented several clinics and workshops on various aspects of music education at universities, conferences and conventions around the country, and has been an adjunct professor of jazz pedagogy at the John J. Cali School of Music at Montclair State University since January of 2011.

Mr. Haas lives in Glen Rock, with his wife Cynthia, and their two daughters, Stefanie and Danielle.



John W. Luckenbill III has been the Associate Director of Bands at Ridgewood High School since the fall of 2011. He currently is the co-director of the Concert Band and Symphonic Band, the director of the Marching Band and brass ensembles, and teaches 21st Century Music Production at RHS. He also taught 5th grade instrumental music at Hawes School during his first 2 years in Ridgewood. Originally from Shrewsbury, NJ, Mr. Luckenbill received a Bachelor of Music Education degree from Michigan State University in the spring of 2011, and his Master of Music in Music Education from Kent State University in spring of 2016.

Since beginning at RHS, Mr. Luckenbill has brought the RHS Marching Band program to new heights; growing the membership from 81 to 115 students in 5 years, and recently earning a 2nd place finish at the 2017 USBands National Championships and the award for Best Music. During Mr. Luckenbill's tenure, the band has received the Cadets Award of Excellence and the Esprit de Corps award multiple times at various USBands competitions. The band was also featured on CBS-WLNY TV's morning show, "The Couch" during the fall of 2013. In 2016, Mr. Luckenbill was named a Positive-Coaching Alliance "Double Goal Coach Award" winner (1 of only 50 in the United States) for his work with the marching band. The award is given to coaches who strive to win while also teach life lessons through their activity.

During his time at Michigan State University, Mr. Luckenbill was in many performing ensembles offered through the University. He was a part of the Spartan Marching Band trumpet section where his peers selected him as trumpet section and squad leader for 3 years during his 5 years in the band. He also participated in the MSU Spartan Brass, the men's and women's basketball and hockey band, where he was section leader for 4 of his 5 years. Marching Band and Spartan Brass led him to travel with each team across the nation to 2 Final Fours and 4 bowl games. Mr. Luckenbill was principal trumpet of the MSU Symphony Band and performed with the MSU Wind Symphony. He performed with a scholarship brass quintet throughout his years at MSU, where they performed outreach concerts and recitals.

During high school, Mr. Luckenbill was selected as principal trumpet in the New Jersey All-State Wind Ensemble, as well as the Region II Wind Ensemble for 2 years. Mr. Luckenbill was also selected into the Hershey's All-USA High School Band from 2004-2005.

Currently, Mr. Luckenbill plays trumpet with many ensembles throughout New Jersey and can be found working as the bugler at Monmouth Park Race-track during the summer months. He most recently played for the 2015 Triple Crown winner's, American Pharoah, winning race at the Haskell Invitational. Mr. Luckenbill lives with his wife, Lisa, their son, William, and their dog, Ruby.

ADJUNCT FACULTY AND STAFF



Gary Fink is the Director of Jazz and Percussion at Ridgewood High School. He founded the RHS Percussion Ensemble in 1986, which has become recognized as a superior group by nationally known clinicians and educators. The ensemble has been regularly chosen to be a part of the Chamber Society of Lincoln Center's Young Musicians Program since 1998, the first and only percussion ensemble to receive that honor in the program's history. In 2001, the ensemble was selected to perform Minoru Miki's Marimba Spiritual on the nationally broadcast radio program "From The Top."

Mr. Fink has also directed the Percussion Ensemble at New Jersey City University from 2003-2008, the USSBA All Star Percussion Ensemble, NJ Region I High School Jazz Ensemble, has toured China as director of HYPE, and since 1992 has toured Europe as a director of the American Music Abroad Red Tour. Mr. Fink was the Principal Percussionist for the Ridgewood Concert Band from 1984-2001. He was a founding member of the Ethos Percussion Group and has performed and conducted in the pit orchestra of over 120 musicals. He has performed as a member of the Hunter Symphony, the New Jersey Percussion Ensemble and for the Pope at Giants Stadium.

Mr. Fink currently teaches music related courses at William Paterson University. He studied music at Eastman School of Music and William Paterson College. In 1998 and 2007, Mr. Fink was awarded a Teacher Recognition Certificate from the National Foundation for the Advancement in the Arts. He has been directly involved with the

revamping of percussion auditions for NJ All-State Band, All-State Jazz Ensembles and the Music Educators of Bergen County. He is the Percussion Coordinator for the North Jersey School Music Association (Region I Band and Orchestra). Mr. Fink is a Yamaha Clinician for symphonic percussion and he also gives clinics and workshops on drum set. He has worked with students in the Region I Jazz Ensemble, Bergen County Band and the Region I Symphonic Band. He is also the director of the Encore Music Studio, the Ridgewood Community School's after school private music lesson program.

James Garde was a member of the Ridgewood High School Marching Band, and graduated from RHS in the spring of 1993. He graduated Magna cum Laude with a degree in Music Education from James Madison University in Harrisonburg, Virginia in 1998. Since then, James has had the opportunity to "come home" and work with the music program in Ridgewood, first as the Marching Band director, and currently as the sax section coach for the Jazz Ensemble and visual tech in Marching Band..

James can be seem in the area appearing with several rock groups, the New jersey Saxophone Ensemble, the pit orchestras for several high school musical productions, and as a musician and volunteer with the Youth Ministry Program at Church of the Presentation in Upper Saddle River. Mr. Garde directs the band program in grades 4 through 8, and teaches the video production classes in the Carlstadt Public School in Carlstadt, NJ.





Patricia Lazzara, flutist, has distinguished herself as a soloist, chamber and orchestral musician. She is a three time winner of the Artists International competition in New York City and gave her critically acclaimed New York recital debut at Cami Hall. Patricia Lazzara has performed as soloist for the National Flute Association Professional Flute Choir and won first prize in the North Jersey Philharmonic Concerto Competition. Ms. Lazzara is a Miyazawa Flute Artist, (www.miyazawa.com), is the 2007 Winner of the Florida Flute Association Performers Grant for Advanced Study, presently studying with Keith Underwood and currently is a Twinz Records Recording Artist. She is a 2004 Winner of the National Flute Association Convention Performers Competition.

Ms. Lazzara has released two CDs for flute and harp entitled "Enchanted Love" and "Celestial Sounds of Christmas". Ms. Lazzara is a founding member of "UpTown Flutes", an innovative flute ensemble in residence at Drew University, Madison, NJ. Their sold out performance at Carnegie's Weill Hall in 2002 received a rave review from the New York

Concert Review and they were invited to perform at The 2003 National Flute Association Convention in Washington, DC.

The "*UpTown Flutes*" debut CD is entitled "A Flute Renaissance" followed by their holiday CD, "An UpTown Christmas" both edited by Patricia. UpTown Flutes' third CD "21st Century Gems" has recently been released.

Ms. Lazzara had the distinct honor of being the flute soloist for the Papal Visit to Giants Stadium in 1995 and is the Events coordinator of the New Jersey Flute Society. She is principal flutist with the Gateway Classical Music Society and the NJ State Opera and she also performs with the Garden State Philharmonic. She attended Carnegie Mellon University and received a Bachelor of Music Degree from the Hartt School of Music where she studied with John Wion, has appeared in master classes with Jean Pierre Rampal, Thomas Nyfenger, Robert Stallman, Trevor Wye and has coached with Jeanne Baxtresser, Michael Parloff and Bart Feller. She also studied with Paige Brook and David Williams. Ms. Lazzara is the Executive Director of "Music for Life", a successful musical instruction program in parochial schools, is on the faculty of the Rockland Conservatory of Music and Ackerman's Music Center in addition to full studio of private students.

Ben Hankle has been a freelance trumpeter in the NYC area since the late 90's. As a youth he was principal trumpet of the NY Youth Symphony and the NJ All-State Wind Ensemble and Orchestra. After graduating college he toured the world performing as lead trumpet for Royal Caribbean and Celebrity cruises. He has performed for the Broadway shows "Chicago" and "Phantom of the Opera" as well as performances of numerous other "off Broadway" productions. Ben is a regular member of the "Savoy Stompers" (pop) the "Honest Eighths" (jazz) and "Clarity Brass" (classical). Ben has had the opportunity to perform and/or record with such artists as Arturo Sandoval, Louie Bellson, Gladys Knight, Phil Smith, Tierney Sutton, Rufus Reid, Wynton Marsalis, and Buddy DeFranco. In addition to teaching Jessica performs in various musical productions as a woodwind doubler and maintains a private studio of clarinet, saxophone, voice, and piano students through the Spotlight Performing Arts Academy in Ridgefield, NJ.



Joe Bergen is an educator and performer working in the New York Metro Area. Joe has worked as the RHS drumline arranger and instructor since 2012. A native of Ramsey NJ, Joe got his start in percussion with lessons from Ridgewood Percussion Director Gary Fink. Joe went on to get a bachelors degree in music performance from William Paterson University studying with percussion virtuosos Tom Kolor and John Ferrari with additional private studies from Juilliard faculty Gordon Gottlieb and Boston Conservatory faculty Nancy Zeltsman. He is currently a teaching artist for NJPAC and Carnegie Hall as well as percussion instructor at Ridgewood High school and percussion director at Montville Township High School where he built the program to be the current 2011 and 2012 USBands Indoor Concert Percussion Champions as well as the 2011 USBands Group III Open National Champions.

As a performer, Joe is an in-demand percussionist having recorded for tv, radio, film, and video game soundtracks (most notably 2010 game of the year Red Dead Redemption.)

He was a four year member of the marching band and served as Field Captain and Drum Major in his final two years. After graduating, Will had a brief stint at Marist College where he studied French. Ultimately, he decided to pursue a degree in Music Education and transferred to Montclair State University. As a tuba player, he was a member of many ensembles at MSU including the Wind Symphony, Tuba Euphonium Ensemble, and pit orchestra. Will developed a passion for conducting from his esteemed professors Dr. Thomas McCauley and Dr. Shelley Axelson. He graduated in 2015 with his Bachelor of Music. From 2008 through 2010, Will was a member of the ten time DCI World Champion Cadets drum and bugle corps. He used that experience to come back to RHS and help with marching band as a visual technician. He has now been on staff in some capacity since 2008, and in the past ten years has increased his responsibilities to include not just visual aspects, but music, show planning, and the organization/coordination of the marching band program. He currently fills the role of the marching band's Assistant Director. He also works with Garfield and Kittatinny High School marching bands.

Patti Wojtowicz has been a proud member of the RHS Marching Band staff since 1978. She has a masters degree in educational psychology and is a career development specialist with the Bergen County Special Services / Technical School District. Patti is a member of the visual staff and specializes in baton twirling. She instructs the RHS indoor twirling program.

Patti is the president of the NJ Twirling Council of the United State Twirling Association and is a certified Level 2 judge. She is the director of the Illumination Twirlers. Her students hold individual and team championships at the state, regional and national level and have gone on to excel as feature twirlers in college. Her own daughter, Catherine, was a feature twirler at the University of South Carolina. Patti and her husband Sam live in Ho-ho-kus.





Michael Klesch is an arranger and clinician for numerous marching bands across the country. In addition to arranging for Ridgewood High School he is the staff arranger for both the University of Alabama Million Dollar Band and the University of Massachusetts Minuteman Marching Band. His degrees come from West Chester University, a B.S. in Music Education, and from the University of Massachusetts, a Masters in Music.

Mr. Klesch was a performer with the Garfield Cadets and finished out his career there as drum major of the 1983 DCI World Champions. After aging-out of drum corps in 1983, Mr. Klesch then served on the Cadets brass staff in 1984 and as the brass arranger for the Cadets from 1985 - 1992 (World Champions in 1985, '87, and '90). He has served as brass arranger for the Phantom Regiment and Crossmen Drum and Bugle Corps and currently serves as the brass arranger and musical director for the Carolina Crown Drum and Bugle Corps.

Elise McAloon is a Music Education student at William Paterson University. She has been playing percussion for 9 years. Elise attended Bridgewater-Raritan high school and marched in the drumline for 4 years.


Program Notes
