Introducing our guest artist...

INGRID JENSEN



Born in Vancouver and raised in Nanaimo, B.C., Ingrid Jensen has been hailed as one of the most gifted trumpeters of her generation. After graduating from Berklee College of Music in 1989, she went on to record three highly acclaimed CDs for the ENJA record label, soon becoming one of the most in-demand players on the global jazz scene. After playing and teaching in Europe in the early 90s, Ingrid settled in New York City where she joined the Grammy-nominated and winning big bands of Maria Schneider and Darcy James Argue, as well as leading her own quintet, quartet and organ trio. Most recently, Ingrid has been performing with the Grammy-winning Terri-Lyne Carrington and her Mosaic project and the Juno-award winning Christine Jensen Jazz Orchestra.

Jensen is a dedicated jazz educator, having taught trumpet at both the University of Michigan and Peabody Conservatory and filling guest artist positions with prestigious University and professional big bands around the world. She was the youngest professor in the history of the Bruckner Conservatory in Linz, Austria, where she served as trumpet professor in the jazz department in her early twenties. She is currently on the faculty at the Manhattan School of Music and Purchase College of Music, both in New York. Jensen has also been a regular guest director with the Thelonious Monk Institute of Jazz, serving as mentor and leader of the all-star high school groups which tour the US on jazz outreach missions.

Jensen has performed and/or recorded with Clark Terry, Esperanza Spalding, Lionel Hampton, Jeff "Tain" Watts, Dianne Reeves, Branford Marsalis, Sarah McLachlan, the Stockholm Jazz Orchestra, Carnegie Hall with the New York Women's Orchestra and Rufus Reid Quiet Pride project. She has been a guest artist with many prestigious universities and colleges including Berklee College of Music, Dartmouth College, Temple University, the Paris Conservatory and USC.

Jensen has toured with her own quartets in Australia, South Africa, almost every country in Europe, across Canada, the US, South America (including Brazil, Peru, and Chile), Japan, Mexico and many other areas, receiving rave reviews and a strong and loyal fan base.

Ingrid plays a custom Monette trumpet, built personally by the master builder Dave Monette.
